

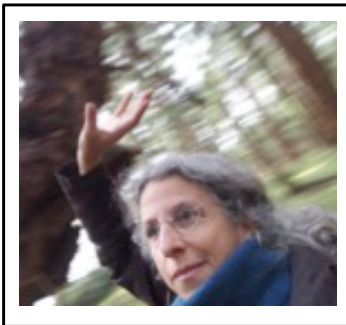
Conscious Beings: Our Beloved Cousins on the Earth
