## **URSA FARM UPDATE**

A seed has been planted in Nova Scotia and is starting to sprout green leaves. What kind of plant will it become? A lily? A healing herbal? Hard to say at this point.

Ursa farmstead is the seed for a potential intentional community inspired by Anthroposophy. It has sixty acres of gently hilled land, a large field ready for new buildings, homes perhaps, a school or an elder care building. The homes built here would overlook the farm below; with its cows, chickens, turkeys and sheep, a large vegetable garden, all tenderly cared for now by Justin and Suzanna. Children come every week to run through the fields, care for the animals, build shelters and fires and other bush craft. The farm school created by Suzanna and Justin has met with a warm response from the wider community. They are looking for another teacher to help his Waldorf inspired school grow.


